

MINUTES OF THE LOUISVILLE BRIDGE ASSOCIATION

ANNUAL MEETING - JANUARY 4, 1967

The Annual Meeting of the Louisville Bridge Association was held January 4, 1967, at the Kentucky Hotel.

Mr. J. Cleve Iler, Jr., President, called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

The Minutes of the previous Annual Meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer's Report was read and a copy filed with the Secretary. Mr. William J. Bell moved that the report of the Treasurer be accepted. Motion carried. The Treasurer left a copy on the head table for members to examine, if they so desired.

The Historian, Mrs. A. C. Litterest, reported the number of tables in play for 1965 and 1966, which included the Southern Tournament, On to the Nationals, Kentucky State, L.B.A. Master Point Games and Winners Games. The overall total for 1966 was a 171 tables, an increase of 35 tables over 1965.

The Vice-President, Mrs. Wilbur Crawford, in her report thanked Mrs. I. W. Campbell, in helping her obtain such satisfactory hotel arrangements for the 1966 tournaments.

The President had Mrs. Crawford present the Trophy for "The Player of the Year" to Mr. Jerry Volpe, who had won 72 Master Points in Louisville Tournaments during 1966.

In the President's Annual Message, he thanked all members who had helped him during the year, and announced that Mrs. I. W. Campbell had been made a member of ACBL's Good-Will Committee.
