

ANNUAL MEETING OF THE LOUISVILLE BRIDGE ASSOCIATION, JANUARY 19, 1970

The Annual Meeting of the Louisville Bridge Association was held January 19, 1970 at the Kentucky Hotel. The President, Mrs. Zue Johantgen, called the meeting to order at 8:10 P.M.

The Minutes of the previous Annual Meeting were approved as read.

In the absence of the Treasurer, Mrs. L. D. Ehrman, the Secretary read a summary of her report:-

Mrs. George Broadus, Historian, reported that we had 146½ more tables in our Sectional Tournaments in 1969 than in 1968, but that we had fewer tables in our Unit Monthly Games.

Mrs. Seymour Weiss, Chairman of the "Player of the Year" Committee, presented the trophy to Thomas S. Reece, who had won 51.60 Master Points in Louisville Tournaments during 1969.

Melvin Keisler, Chairman of the J. Cleve Iler, Jr. Trophy Committee, presented the trophy to Mrs. Arthur Zubrod, which stands for "Ethics, Courtesy and Sportsmanship."

The highlights from the President's Annual Report are:-

1. Membership for 1969 was 649, a decrease of 126 members from 1968
2. The Unit had eight new Life Masters in 1969, six were from Louisville, and the total is now 60.
3. For the second year, winners of our March Continent-Wide Charity Game, Mrs. W. A. Sparks and Thomas S. Reece, won National recognition for being second overall in the nation.
4. From our Local Charity Game, held December 14, 1969, we presented the Rehabilitation Center with a check for \$234.00, which was put in a Fund for children whose families are unable to pay their expenses.
5. All Officers, Directors and committee workers were thanked for their service to her during the past two years.
6. The incoming Board was welcomed with a challenge to steer the Organization in the right direction.
