The annual meeting of the Louisville Bridge Association was held at the Marriott Inn, Clarksville, Indiana on July 13, 1981. The meeting was called to order by the President, Jane Naiser at 7:30 P. M.

The minutes of the last Annual Meeting were read by the Secretary, Vivian Schmitt, and approved after correction. The membership report was ^{read} showing a total of 812 members as of July 1, 1981.

The Treasurer, Verna Goldberg, gave a report of LBA finances from January 1, 1981 to June 30, 1981. Income for that period totaled \$8,917.49. Expenses were \$2,227.21. Profit \$6,690.28. Total assets as of June 30, 1981: \$37,526.88. The report was ordered filed and audited.

Bob Daggy, Historian, presented his report.

The President reminded the membership that her report had already been published in the recent Kibitzer but reviewed highlights of the previous year, namely:

Relocation of the Bridge Center at 4109 Oechsli Ave.

Investment of LBA Funds in Certificates of Deposit, with increased income to offset losses incurred by Sectional tournaments.

Implementation of a new Sectional Tournament at Western Kentucky University to be held in May 1982.

The President then presented ACBL Presidential Awards to those members who had made outstanding efforts toward the move to the new Center. Other members who had done exceptional work for the organization during the past year were recognized and thanked for their contributions. The President, then, commended the membership for the high level of participation in the activities of the organization and their help in making the past a most successful year.

Marge Eldred, Vice-President, in behalf of the Board of Directors, presented a plaque to the President, in gratitude for her leadership and direction in securing and accomplishing the successful move of the Bridge Center to the new quarters.

The President introduced the Board of Directors, retiring and continuing, thanked them for their work and support. The results of the election was then announced. Elected as directors were the following:
