

ANNUAL MEETING JULY 8, 1982

The 1982 Annual Meeting of the Louisville Bridge Association was held at Executive West on July 8, The President, Jane Naiser, called the meeting to order at 7:30 P. M.

Flowers and an enscribed cup were presented to the unit's newest Life Master, Dottie Robertson. Jim Washer, Player of the Year Chairman, presented cups to Club Player of the Year, Bill Penton, and Tournament Player of the Year, Dorothy Weiss.

The minutes of the 1981 Annual Meeting were read and approved. Current membership was reported at 836 members, an increase of twenty members over the preceding year.

Treasurer, Verna Goldberg, gave a report on the recent Western Kentucky University Tournament and a financial report on the January 1-June 30, 1982 period. Total assets, as of June 30, 1982, were \$43,107.00

The Historian, Bob Daggy, reported a total of 1332.5 tables in play during the 1981-82 year. When one excludes the table count from large Regionals, held in both the 1980-81 and 1979-80 periods, the 1982 total exceeds the 1979-80 period by 213 tables and the 80-81 period by 268 tables. He, also, gave interesting statistics on winners in various club and unit tournaments. Six new Life Masters were reported for the year.

The President, in her remarks to the membership, commented on the move of the Bridge Center in Louisville to new quarters; the large increase in tables at play at the Center; the increase in unit assets during her term in office of, approximately \$20,000.00; and announced awards of Charity Funds, rebated from ACBL, to the Muhlenberg County ~~Spouse Abuse~~ Center and the Greater Louisville Diabetes Children's Camp Fund. *opportunity*

She thanked the Board of Directors and other individuals who had made exceptional contributions and congratulated them on an outstanding job. The members of the Board of Directors were each introduced. The tellers were thanked for their assistance in the election. The results of the election were announced and the newly elected members were introduced, as follows:
