Louisville Bridge Association

The annual meeting of the Louisville Bridge Association was held at the Holiday Inn, Fern Valley Road June 14, 1984. The President, Dorothy Weiss, called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

Nancy Harpring read the Secretary's report which was approved.

The Treasurer, Verna Goldberg, reported that we have assets of \$2,759.50 in LBA money at The Cumberland; the Bridge Center has \$1,542.53 at First National Bank; ready cash access for the Center of \$5,324.32; Merrill Lynch savings account for the LBA of \$26,000; Merrill Lynch savings account the the Center of \$6,000; and a liquor inventory of \$280.82, for a profit to date of \$46,271.22. The Treasurer's report was approved and ordered file for audit.

In the absence of the Historian Connie Shortreed, Verna Goldberg read her report showing seven new life masters this year and 17 during the 1982/83 year.

The President reported that we had 51 new members this year and asked that everyone make them feel welcome.

She also informed us that we had an interest income of \$4,730 for 1983 which helped to offset our operating loss of \$5,665. This loss includes depreciation of \$2,377 and, therefore, we actually had a cash flow increase of \$1,442.

We have invested \$27,000 in certificates of deposit paying 13 3/4% and \$5,000 in certificates paying 12%. The Bridge Center has over \$5,000 invested in a ready access account for a total of over \$37,000 in investments.

This year we have donated to charity \$750 to the Ronald McDonald House, \$750 to the J. Graham Brown Cancer Foundation, and \$370.50 to the Warren County Cancer Center.

This past year we have installed an electronic filter in our heating and cooling system for the elimination of smoke.

Also for the first time, a two-day Swiss Team was held at Bowling Green in May of this year.

Little McKenny awards were presented to: Dyan Vaughn, Rookie of the Year; Jo Ann Axton, Non-Master of the Year; Mr. J.M. Tuggle, Master of the Year; Ella Hall, National Master of the Year; Pat Buckley, Senior Master of the Year; Susan Wilson, Advanced Senior Master of the Year; and Marinesa Letizia, Life Master of the Year.

Club Player of the Year went to Jane Naiser; Downstate Player of the Year to Mrs. D. Beard of Campbellsville; and Novice of the Year to Glenda Hart.

New officers are: President, Verna Goldberg; Vice President, Liz Jacobs; Secretary, Carolyn Leachman; Treasurer, Betty Stevens; Historian, Sue Schmurr


Amendment: Passed
